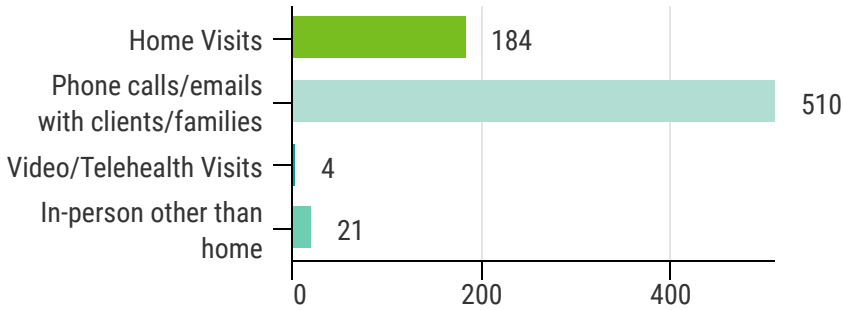

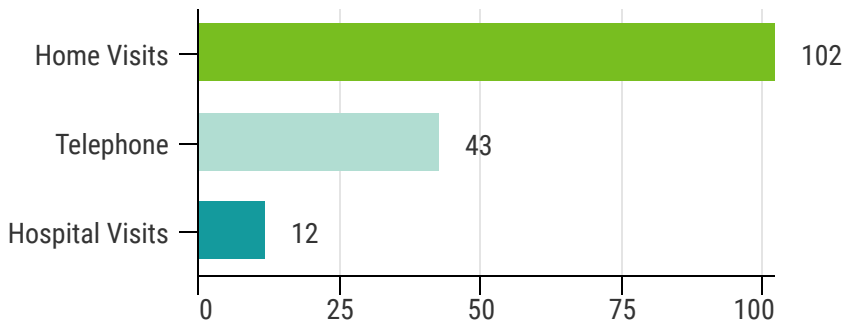

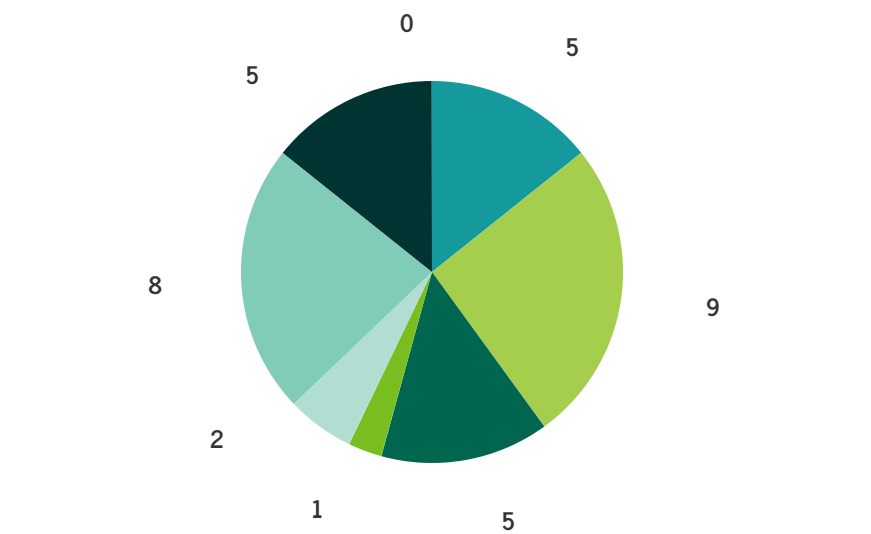
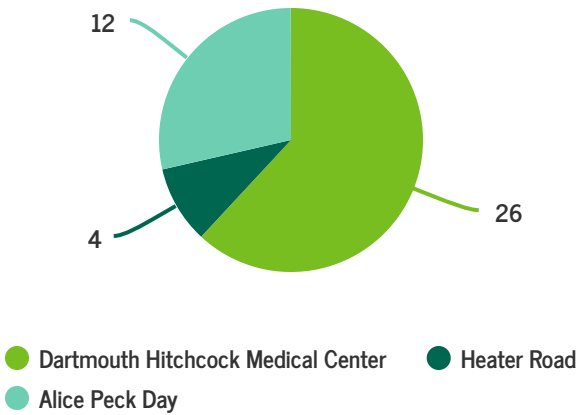
Community Paramedic Encounter Types 1/1/2022- 6/30/2022
