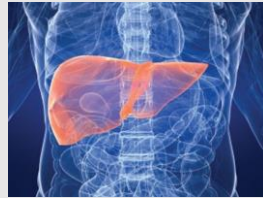

- **Hepatitis C is a virus that affects your liver.**
- **Your liver is important to your whole health.** It removes toxins and waste from your body.
- If left **untreated**, Hepatitis C can lead to **liver failure** or **liver cancer**.
- Hepatitis C is **contagious** through **blood to blood contact**.



- Tattoos and piercing
- Pregnancy and childbirth
- Sex if blood is involved
- Sharing injection equipment, razors or anything that can cause blood to blood contact
