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## TRAUMA AND GENDER DIVERSITY

This two hour training will focus on understanding the spectrum of gender diversity and the higher risk of trauma experiences for youth who identify as gender diverse. ## CREATIVE TRAUMA INFORMED CLINICAL INTERVENTIONS FOR WORKING WITH YOUTH WITH IDD

Youth with IDD are often overlooked when we are thinking about providing trauma-informed mental health services. Many of the modalities we use (TF-CBT, CPP, EMDR) can be adapted for working with youth with IDD or Autism. This training will provide concrete tools for adapting your clinical work for youth with IDD and/or Autism using case studies as examples.
